School Office

Message from Julie:

The school office is open from Monday to Friday 8.00am to 4.00pm and is closed for lunch from 12.00 to 12.30pm.

Julie (our School Secretary) works from Monday to Wednesday and Lin (our Clerical Assistant) works Thursday to Friday and alternate Wednesdays. This is a slight reduction in office hours from last term and so we are currently looking at ways to streamline practices in the office to keep disruptions to a minimum, allowing for a productive workflow. **One of the areas we are looking at is telephone calls and with this in mind we are kindly asking parents to avoid using Option 2 - speak to someone in the office - until after 10.30 am each day.** You can of course still leave messages with us regarding absences on the absence line at any time - Option 1 - and you can also use this to leave other messages (such as After School or Breakfast Club requirements) that we will pick up throughout the day.

If your call is a matter of urgency then of course please do press Option 2 to come through and speak to one of the office staff.
